## Chairman's report

We have now been running with two branches of "our bank" for the latter half of 2009 and I look forward with enthusiasm to the coming years.

Cowes has been an outstanding success and is poised to carry on fulfilling its great promise. We have already exceeded our 30 June 2010 holdings as forecast in the prospectus.

San Remo, after six and a half years, has returned in excess of \$330,000 in sponsorships and grants to the community and is very well placed to continue to contribute.

The Grantville committee have continued their drive towards a **Community Bank**<sup>®</sup> branch and now have in excess of \$400,000 pledged. We expect to have a feasibility study done in March 2010 and depending on the resulting figures Grantville could have a **Community Bank**<sup>®</sup> branch next year.

One only has to see what these **Community Bank**<sup>®</sup> branches are doing throughout Australia to see the great benefits to local communities. Unfortunately a lot of people do not understand the concept of the split of profit in that although 50% of each branches "profit" is returned, not all is put back to the owners i.e. the shareholders. About 80% of the profit (after expenses) is returned to the community via sponsorships, grants and donations. The remainder may be retained for dividends or used to purchase necessary assets.

My sincere thanks go to our hard working diligent staff, the Directors who have continued to work free of charge over the past seven years, and to all our increased number of shareholders.
